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
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



One Direction was The band of our generation. In 5 years of making music and touring the world together, Harry Styles, Zayn Malik, Lima Payne, Louis Tomlinson, and Niall Horan have become irreplaceable parts of our lives. So, the world went into a massive shock when the news of Liam Payne, a beloved former member of One Direction tragically falling to his death in Argentina was published. On Wednesday, October 16, Payne fell from a third-floor hotel balcony in Buenos Aires and then died on the spot before even giving anyone else the chance to take him to the hospital. According to a preliminary autopsy report, Payne died of "multiple traumas" and "internal and external bleeding." around 25 injuries were reported in the late singer's body. The report also stated that the massive head injuries that the singer got from the fall were enough to cause his death. But was it normal? Especially, if you think of falling from a third floor, can it really kill anyone so easily and instantly? The answer is both yes and no depending on how Payne fell on the ground and if he were in a normal state. Now with the toxicology report, it is clear that Payne had "multiple substances in his system" at the time of his death, one of which is known as "pink cocaine".





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
Olivia Rodrigo's 'GUTS World Tour' Special Will Go Live On Netflix

The Electronic Dance Music was not as famous or loved by the elders as much as it is loved by the Gen Z or Gen Alpha, and there are some reasons for that. This blog will help you to dive deeper into the origin, the uprising, and the evolution of Electronic Dance Music to get a better understanding of this genre. The evolution of Electronic Dance Music from its experimental beginnings to its current dominance over the music world is a fascinating story spanning over a century.

Let's get to know in detail about the pioneers of this genre that gave Electronic Dance Music a new path and also gave birth to many sub-genres from EDM to electro-pop to techno house to melodic techno. Electronic music has carved a new path in the music industry, transcending time and cultural boundaries to become a global phenomenon. Since the comeback of live concerts in 2021, the global electronic music industry has witnessed a comeback too, with Electronic Dance Music (EDM) artists being particularly sought after globally for music festivals.

What is EDM or Electronic Dance Music?

Electronic Dance Music is a compilation of electronic music subgenres that are intended for crowds of dancers, including disco music, synthpop, techno, house music, trance music, drum and bass, dubstep, trap, hardstyle, and more. With such a wide range of sounds, it would be impossible to classify all of this at the same time as EDM, but these subgenres have developed over the last few decades, informing and transforming out of a progressive dance culture. The mixes from the 70s, 80s, 90, or even the 2000s are a lot different from what the world witnesses as EDM today. Its progression as a recognizable genre can be mapped out by understanding when its subgenres were popularized as forms of dance music.

Roots of EDM: It is quite easy to detect the main motive of any EDM track. The main aim of the mixes is to make people groove and dance which is a lot similar to what the disco music used to do. So, it is safe to say that the earliest signs of EDM were recognized from disco music of the 1970s. Two of the most popular disco music that helped in creating the EDM scene include Donna Summer's 1977 synthesized disco hit 'I Feel Love' which was written by Pete Bellotte and Giorgio Moroder who was later seen to be collaborating with Daft Punk and the 1974 hit track 'Rock Your Baby' by George McCrae, which used a drum machine and Roland rhythm machine.

The origins of electronic music can be in the 1940s and 1950s when pioneering artists like Karlheinz Stockhausen and Pierre Schaeffer began experimenting with electronic instruments and sound manipulation. The invention of the Theremin which was one of the first electronic musical instruments played without physical contact the legendary by Lev Sergeyevich Termen (Léon Theremin), and the Telharmonium by Thaddeus Cahill were early milestones that set the stage for future innovations.

Early electronic music was primarily composed of tape loops, synthesizers, and other electronic instruments that created avant-garde and experimental compositions that challenged conventional musical norms. The Buchla and Moog synthesizers were a few of the earliest synthesizers which were commercially available, and which enabled musicians to create brandnew, out-of-this-world sounds.

The 1980s: Alongside house music, synth music or synthpop was developed in the post-disco era in the 1980s. Music created and produced in this era began to be known as mainstream music in Europe as electronic dance music became more sophisticated and robust

with technological advancements. Drum machines and synthesizers were used more heavily in the post disco times, but these electronic music producers were joined by innovations like MIDI, which revolutionized the way electronic instruments could express emotions and create new soundscapes. Paired with the use of computers, electronic music took off as an accessible art form that could be replicated and transformed by anyone with musical experience and a computer. The sounds created during this period of time included hits like a-ha's 'Take On Me' and the song would come to be recognized as one of the first, (if not the first) house records, 'On and On', by Jesse Saunders.

The 1990s: The new generation is more familiar with the EDM sound created in the 90s and these come under the subgenres of techno music, house music, hardcore rave, dub, trance, and drum and bass. In the '90s, electronic dance music was still trying to excel as a mainstream music genre, and the inclusion of these new subgenres helped shoot it into popularity, making EDM a part of the mainstream music industry like never before, especially in Europe. It was then that the rave scene began to grow into what it is today, with nightclubs featuring popular and even underground EDM records.

Some of the most popular songs of this time were 'Chime' and 'Halcyon On and On' by the British group 'Orbital'. The U.S. saw the beginning of 'Detroit Techno' in the late 80s and 90s which was pioneered by the 'Belleville Three' including Derrick May, who produced music under the names Mayday and Rhythim is Rhythim. His song, 'Strings of Life' is still widely recognized as a classic house and techno record that has defined the techno genre in the U.S.

The 2000s: The EDM was the turtle in this race, it started to grow very slowly but it had a stable pace which gave it the upper hand in the early 2000s. It eventually picked up the pace and popularity in the U.S. and all the credit goes to eminent EDM musicians, international DJs, and music producers who drew attention to the genre as well as the techno-pop 1998 album by Madonna, 'Ray of Light'. Internationally acclaimed EDM musicians like Tiesto, Daft Punk, and David Guetta paved a new direction for this style of music. These artists created a name for themselves in the mainstream music industry and they are still topping the charts. In the early 2000s, dubstep was also introduced to the U.S. music industry through artists like Skrillex, a Grammy-winning EDM artist with sounds

of dubstep, house, trap, and more. Today, EDM is often characterized by remixes and original sound mixes, produced by world-famous DJs like The Chainsmokers, Steve Aoki, Martin Garrix, and others, in addition to the ever-relevant Skrillex, David Guetta, Daft Punk, and Tiësto. Electronic dance music and its subgenres are now used by a large majority of pop and hip-hop artists, including the likes of Coldplay, Justin Bieber, Selena Gomez, Drake, Taylor Swift, Katy Perry, Alessia Cara, and countless others.

SELENA GOMEZ REVEALS THE DARK REASON BEHIND WHY SHE DOES NOT SLEEP IN HER BEDROOM

Selena Gomez, the eminent singer and actress is getting candid about her mental health. She just revealed why she no longer sleeps in her bedroom.

The Only Murders in the Building actress, 32, opened up about how a dark period in her life is associated with her bedroom and has made her uncomfortable sleeping there.

During Wondermind's Mental Fitness Summit on Thursday, Oct. 10, Selena Gomez got candid about her ongoing struggles with mental health when the revelation of her not being comfortable enough to sleep in her bedroom came.

Gomez and her mom Mandy Teefey are co-founders of this mental health platform and at this virtual event, both were key speakers.

When Gomez spoke about the topic, her mom quickly came to her side and revealed that she tends to crawl up in her bed and "do bed rotting" whenever she is anxious about her future. "I'm a little bit different than my mom because I spent too much time in my bedroom that I actually don't even sleep in my bedroom anymore," the Wizards of Waverly Place star said.

She further revealed that she associates her bedroom "with such a really dark time." She continued, "Being anxious is so debilitating sometimes. I didn't want to leave my bed for years."

Gomez further added that "part of it is I wasn't doing the work. You have to believe in yourself and do the work that will truly enlighten you a little bit, even if that is watching a show for 30 minutes." After revealing that she no longer sleeps in her bedroom to avoid evoking those "dark" feelings, the singer said that she

still struggles with insomnia.

She further admitted that it was difficult for her to fall asleep and that she fell asleep at 4 a.m. before the night of this event. "It was just because my mind was simply racing and I just kept saying over and over again, 'This will pass, just let it go through your body and it'll go away.' And of course, eventually, I fell asleep."

The 'Love You Like a Love Song' singer has always been open about her struggles with mental health and has taken the step to break the stigma around it. The singer released her tell-all documentary My Mind & Me in 2022. The documentary detailed the bipolar disorder diagnosis of Gomez in 2019, and how the star was suicidal for quite some time, leading to her hospitalization in 2018.



In an exclusive interview with PEOPLE, the singer opened up about her mental health journey. "In the beginning, it seemed hopeless," she told the interviewer about her dark feelings at the time.

"Sometimes it was a challenge for me to even get out of bed. I was like, 'Why can't I be like you guys?' Over the years, I've finally found my rhythm, but it took me time."

She continued, "I've tried a ton of different things, but the one thing I've never stopped doing is asking for help. That was the hardest part, but I truly believe that that's why I'm stronger. This is something that is the most important thing in the world to me 'cause it's my mental health."

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Sarod Maestro Avra Banerjee's Much Anticipated Album 'Memory of Melodies'

The prolific sarod player Avra Banerjee is back again as a composer with his fusion of Indian Classical music and World music compiled in an album called 'Memory of Melodies'.

Recently fusion music is creating a buzz among the audience and the music industry. This shows how much versatile the perception of the listeners has become. Adding fuel to this glorious fire is the profound musician Avra Banerjee's new album 'Memory of Melodies' which is a compilation of 8 songs that are bound to bring back the memories of the good old times.

The third song is called 'Harmony of Rhapsody' which portrays the mind-bending blend of flute played by Shashank Subramaniyam, violin played by Ambi Subramaniam, bass guitar played by Bachospati Chakraborty, and music composed and designed by sarod maestro Avra Banerjee which is based on intricate time cycle of 8.5 and transitioning between 8 and 9 beat time cycles. The fourth song of the album is 'Classically Perth' which showcases the soulcapturing voice of Amitav Islam, the intricate tabla playing of Gurpreet Singh and Sivakumar along with the magical sarod played by Praashekh Borkar.

The fifth song is called 'Jo Tum Mile' another one rendered by Hariharan which is like an anthem of soulful music and the unique flair of the sarod maestro has lifted the track onto a new height. The sixth track of the album is called 'Tujhme Fana Kar De' which is sung by Raghab Chatterjee with of course the infusion created by the sarod maestro. The song speaks of spirituality and a higher power that can salvage the human soul. The harmonium played in the middle is commendable and the lyrics along with the hooking rhythm are hard to get out of the mind.

The seventh track is called 'Silent Embrace' which features one of the most honest and soothing musical tapestry of Indian music, composed by Aranya Banerjee who is son of Avra Banerjee, performed by Tamal Kanti Halder on piano and Avra Banerjee on sarod. The enticing rhythm along with the melodious piano creates an enigmatic flow that sets the stage for the sarod to take up a deserving space in the track. The eighth track of the album is called 'Saqi Nazar Se' which shows how effortlessly bass guitar can be blended with a classical instrument like sarod. The soothing and melodic voice of Amitav Islam binds it all together to create a masterpiece.

In short, this album is a great fit for those who like to take it slow and enjoy the richness Indian Classical music has to offer but do not want to compromise their Western choices.

American Music Awards debuted on Feb. 19, 1974, and the industry has had many changes since then. Now, on its 50th anniversary, here are some takeaways. American Music Awards has been a very successful fan-driven alternative to the Grammy Awards since it debuted on February 19th, 1974. Since then, the music industry has gone through so many changes, new talents have risen, and reigning talents sometimes saw a decline in the masses. To honor the long reign, the American Music Awards 50th Anniversary Special was released as a two-hour-long show was aired on Sunday, October 6th. The special captured many of these changes that happened in the industry over the years in fresh performances and segments that were smartly curated.

The show recently changed networks, from ABC to CBS. CBS aired the anniversary special and will also air the next regular AMA broadcast in May.

The original plan was to debut on the new network with a simple best-ofthe-past-year broadcast. However, the plan changed and the audience was reminded of the award show's history before its re-launching. The third co-host of the first show, Smokey Robinson introduced the segment on the anniversary show. He was also one of the six co-hosts of the AMAs to appear along with Gloria Estefan, Jennifer Lopez, Reba McEntire, Jimmy Kimmel, and Cedric the Entertainer. Here are some of the highlights from the anniversary special show.


The special opened with a clip package from the first show, including Stevie Wonder playing 'Superstition'. It also included Gladys Knight & the Pips performing 'Midnight Train to Georgia.' Both tracks remain toptier classics to date and were No. 1 Billboard hits in 1973. The show then cut to Gladys Knight performing 'Midnight Train to Georgia' live. Another highlight from the show was the montage of country superstars who appeared on the AMA stage. They culminated in Kane Brown, who performed a relaxed version of 'Drive (For Daddy Gene)', Alan Jackson's 2002 hit, leading to his own current hit 'Miles on It'.

Jennifer Hudson, the EGOT recipient honored the legend and 22-time AMA winner Whitney Houston. She created a medley of Houston's performance on the 1994 AMAs. This medley contained the tracks 'I Loves You, Porgy' from Porgy & Bess and 'I Will Always Love You' from The Bodyguard.

Another highlight from the special was when Hip-hop finally got its dues. The American Music Awards did not have a Hip-hop category until the 16th show in 1989. At the special for the 50th anniversary this year, a clip was shown which had the collection of show moments with groundbreaking stars of hip-hop, Jay-Z, Snoop Dogg, Dr. Dre, Nicki Minaj, Cardi B, Megan Thee Stallion, Post Malone, Missy Elliott. Here we saw Dr. Dre had the best line accepting his award and telling his mother, "I guess all that music coming out of my bedroom paid off." The anniversary show also created a segment of outrageous moments throughout the history of the American Music Awards.

The segment included Vanilla Ice and Billy Ray Cyrus just blasting their critics while accepting their awards. Apart from this, the show also had a parade from the boy bands. Kevin: That is a very tough question to answer. I just have such a passion for music. I feel the anticipation of wanting it to be heard by as many as possible, I believe that the release has given me such great pleasure.

DMR: What do you aim to achieve through the new album?

Kevin: This project was about hoping to make the works I did before sound better. I know that in the past it has encompassed growing pains. Even George Martin said the same about the Beatles when he first met them the writing was ok, but he had seen they had charisma with a potential to be better. I know I haven't made professional status even with this recording, but I do feel that compared to 2 years ago I have gotten

DMR: Any special thought that came to you that influenced this album?

Kevin: Just to bring joy and love into the hearts of all that get the opportunity to hear this compilation.

DMR: People are becoming fans of your music. So, how is the stardom treating you?

Kevin: I am very humble to that fact. I am still a small fry in the industry. I have had a few of my fans that mentioned me being a star to them. It is flattering.

Kevin: I do feel most of the 16 songs did get better, even though my skills on these weren't of the highest capacity because most of them came from my early catalogue of music and I was as they say green. Please keep an open mind.

DMR: In this universe you're a professional and loved musician, but what do you think you would be in a parallel universeand why?

Kevin: For many years I loved the game of bowling and had made some decent accomplishments.

DMR: Have you ever thought about giving up when you got stuck with a composition? If so, how did you come over that situation?

Kevin: Unfortunately the answer is yes. Even recently, whether it be lyrical, instrumental, arrangement or even production. Sometimes you just take a step back and go to other people that I entrust and ask what their thoughts and suggestions they deem that might work best.

DMR: Any advice for the young-blooded artists who are trying to express their musical talent?



In the caption, she expressed her thoughts regarding the night and shared how significant the night is for her by stating, 'Last night I performed in my hometown, London, at The Royal Albert Hall... joining me on stage to sing our song together.' The good news for the fans who did not get to attend the show is the night of glamour will air on TV for them to watch. The show has been filmed for a TV concert program which is set to air later this year.

She announced this on her Instagram, revealing that the concert will air on CBS in the U.S. and on ITV in the U.K. She also added, 'I wanted to remember this show forever so we captured it to share with you too'.

An Evening with Dua Lipa — featuring performances of some of her greatest hits — is set to premiere on Dec. 15 and is produced by Fulwell 73 Productions and Radical22. The concert was commissioned for ITV by Lily Wilson. During the concert, Dua performed her 2024 album Radical Optimism in full with new arrangements provided by The Heritage Orchestra, conducted by Ben Foster.

The show saw live debuts for songs such as 'End of an Era' and

'French Exit,' as well as singles 'Houdini' and 'Training Season.' Her entry to the Barbie soundtrack, 'Dance the Night,' also got its first live airing.

The setlist also contained performances of 'Don't Start Now' and 'Levitating' from her 2020 album Future Nostalgia, and 'Be The One' from her 2017 self-titled debut. The tour will continue through 2025, with performances in Europe, Australia, and North America. It will conclude in the U.S. next October, with a final stop at Climate Pledge Arena in Seattle on Oct. 16, 2025.

The main festival is being hosted at its usual home, Parc del Fòrum, from June 5 to 7, and will host performances by a total of 147 artists from all around the world. This newly announced fresh lineup includes artists like LCD

Soundsystem, FKA Twigs, HAIM, Jamie xx, Fontaines D.C., Beach House, IDLES, Clairo, Turnstile, Sturgill Simpson, ANOHNI and the Johnsons, MJ Lenderman, Aminé, Magdalena Bay, and Waxahatchee.

FKA Twigs will be returning to the bill after her performance was canceled last year. Performances from others will stretch through the entire week at venues in Barcelona.

The dozens of other artists who will be attending the stage of Primavera Sound Barcelona 2025 and are scheduled to perform include the names of Floating Points, Stereolab, Cat Power playing Dylan, Idles, Frost Children, Been Stellar, Beabadoobee, Denzel Curry, Jamie

Blige, Cher, Dave Matthews Band, Foreigner, Peter Frampton, Kool & The Gang, Ozzy Osbourne, and A Tribe Called Quest. The honorees of the Musical Excellence Award included big names like the late Jimmy Buffett, MC5, Dionne Warwick, and Norman Whitfield.

But apart from the awards there were a few moments that made the night unforgettable to the audience, some of them are mentioned below:

Cher's Change of HeartThe evening started with Dua Lipa in a long black leather dress hinged with delicate chains over fishnet stockings, belting Cher's anthem 'Believe'. She is then joined by Cher in leather chaps and the due joined hands while hitting the chorus of the 1998 comeback song. After Zendaya delivered Cher's induction, she began her acceptance speech by addressing the elephant in the room. She said that it was easier for her to get two divorces than it was getting in the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame.

The five-and-a-half-hour ceremony intertwined moving speeches and career highlight reels with performances that repeatedly brought the packed house to its feet.


Madonna's brother, Christopher Ciccone, died at the age of 63 years on Friday. The pop music artist shared a tribute to her brother as he was the closest to her.

It's hard to explain our bond but it grew out of an understanding that we were different and society was going to give us a hard time for not following the status quo'.

She also added that says 'We took each other's hands and we danced

through the madness of our childhood. In fact dance was a kind of superglue that held us together. Discovering Dance in our small Midwestern town saved me and then my brother came along, and it saved him too. My ballet Teacher, also named Christopher, created a safe space for my brother to be Gay, a word that was not spoken or even whispered where we lived.'



'When I finally got the courage to go to New York to become a Dancer, my brother followed. And again we took each other's hands, and we danced through the madness of New York City! We devoured Art and Music and Film like hungry animals, we were in the epicenter of all of these things exploding. We danced through the madness of the AIDS epidemic. We went to funerals and we cried, and we went dancing.'

The pop artist showed her grief as both of them worked together for a long time in their musical career. She even said 'The last few years have not been easy. We did not speak for some time but when my brother got sick, we found our way back to each other.

I did my best to keep him alive as long as possible. He was in so much pain towards the end. Once again, we held hands. We closed our eyes and we danced. Together.

I'm glad he's not suffering anymore. There will never be anyone like him. I know he's dancing somewhere.'

So, the world went into a massive shock when the news of Liam Payne, a beloved former member of One Direction tragically falling to his death in Argentina was published. According to Liam's toxicology, the singer's system had several drugs including pink cocaine, a recreational drug that is typically created by mixing methamphetamine, ketamine,

MDMA, cocaine, benzodiazepine, and crack. The sources said that an aluminum pipe to ingest the drugs was also found in his hotel bedroom.






Doja Cat Teases Her Upcoming Music Project By Writing Only One Word


Cat. I love her," and further added, "Doja Cat, for sure, is my next goal." While musical creations might have been to a halt, Doja Cat is quite active on the performer side.





Within 24 hours of the launch of the OMV, the music video instantly became the most-liked and fastest duet to hit 10 million views on YouTube this year.


While 'Fortnight' received the Best Collab award at the Video Music Awards 2024, 'APT.' is winning the hearts of the listeners. The music video for the track is



O'Neill Fernandes Shares Glimpses from His Life, and Passion for Music



Paying homage to Australian artists and bands, O'Neill Fernandes is set to release his 50th album is a double album with side 'Great Southern Land' and Side B: 'Shades Of The Shads...Vol.4'.

DMR: Can you tell us briefly about your background and what inspired you to pursue music?

O'Neill: I was born in India (Bombay) and migrated to Perth Australia with my family in 1972. I was influenced by my late father, Austin. He harbored a strong love for the art and gave me early exposure to music. I immersed myself in sing-along sessions and picked up my guitar, which is how I started. Between 1992 and 2001, I also honed my craft as a mobile DJ.

DMR: How did you first get started with producing music, and what has your journey been like so far

O'Neill: During a family sing-along in 2010, I realized how much I enjoyed the musical scene. So, I taught myself to play the guitar again and my wife Linda suggested I record my music. Soon I started experimenting and creating my versions of the songs I played as a DJ. I also taught myself the intricacies of music production through trial and error. Every Album taught me more about music both as a guitarist and producer.

DMR: How has your sound evolved since you first began creating music?

O'Neill: . Initially, my music featured a near-acoustic softness and uplifting melodies. Then I incorporated more diverse elements and explored various genres.

DMR: What's your creative process like when you start working on a new track?

O'Neill: I often start with a spark of inspiration which might be something that catches my interest. Then I craft the melody around what inspired me, forming a backbone for the project. I try to experiment with different sounds and instruments to find the perfect blend. Once the melody is set, I focus on writing lyrics that complement the music. Then I use various techniques and modern music 'plug-ins' to enhance the sound and I spend time refining the track. I take suggestions from my wife sometimes and then shift my focus to final mixing and mastering.

DMR: Do you have a favorite instrument or tool you like to use in your music production?

O'Neill: Yes, I have a particular fondness for electric and acoustic guitars. I also like using the saxophone and modern synths in my compositions.

DMR: How do you find inspiration for your compositions, and what keeps you motivated to keep creating?

O'Neill: I draw inspiration from a variety of sources. They can be my personal experience, or the music, and artists that I love. One of the key factors that keeps me motivated is my desire to bring joy to people's faces through my music.

DMR: Who are some of your biggest musical influences, and how have they shaped your sound?

O'Neill: My music is deeply rooted in the rich tapestry of Australian pop and rock history and is a homage to the iconic sounds of Australian musicians. Some of my biggest influences include Australian Crawl, Little River Band, The Beatles, Queen, Cliff Richard, The Shadows, Electric Light Orchestra, Engelbert, etc.

DMR: Your music has a unique style. How would you describe it to someone who hasn't heard your work before?

O'Neill: I view my music as a vibrant blend of classic

rock, instrumental covers, and reimagined hits. My style includes soulful guitar work and experimenting with diverse genres.

DMR: Do you have a particular genre or vibe you aim for, or do you prefer to experiment with different sounds?

O'Neill: I have a strong foundation in pop, classic rock, and instrumental covers. But, I don't limit myself to one genre.

DMR: Can you tell us about your latest release and what listeners can expect from it?

O'Neill: My 50th Album is a double album with Side A dedicated to Australian Artists and Bands. The 8th Australian Album (Great Southern Land) from the project dedicated to Australian Artists and Bands covers the period 1965 to 2005. The music of the Shadows is what got me interested in learning to play the Guitar. So, 'Shades of the Shads...Vol.4' comprises 28 tracks that cover the period 1960 to 2024 and is Side B of the 50th Album.

DMR: Are there any upcoming projects or collaborations you're excited about?

O'Neill: I have had many invitations for collaboration from artists across the globe but have declined them due to the unpredictability of my state of health.

DMR: If you could collaborate with any artist, living or past, who would it be and why?

O'Neill: I have a few. Hank Marvin, Cliff Richard, ELO, and Queen.

DMR: How has your experience been sharing your music on SoundCloud?

O'Neill: This platform has allowed me to reach a global audience. So, the experience has been good.

DMR: What role does your fanbase play in your creative process, and how do you engage with them?

O'Neill: I value their feedback and often draw inspiration from their comments and suggestions. I engage with my listeners on SoundCloud, YouTube, and Facebook.

DMR: Are there any memorable comments or feedback from fans that have particularly resonated with you?

O'Neill: Yes, sometimes they tell me my music has uplifted them at a time of sadness, which keeps me going.

DMR: What have been some of the biggest challenges you've faced as an artist, and how have you overcome them?

O'Neill: Apart from health struggles, the sheer volume of work involved in producing and releasing music independently is what I felt challenging. This is why I maintained a disciplined approach.

DMR: What do you hope people take away from listening to your music?

O'Neill: A sense of nostalgia and joy.

DMR: What are your goals for the future, both as an artist and in your personal life?

O'Neill: I want to create and release new music, explore different genres, and perhaps collaborate with other musicians.

DMR: If you could describe your music career in three words, what would it be?

O'Neill: Passionate, Prolific, and Resilient.

DMR: What's one thing people would be surprised to learn about you?

O'Neill: One surprising fact about me is that I am entirely self-taught. I did not have any formal music education, but my dedication has allowed me to now become a composer, guitarist, producer, and even a mobile DJ.
